




Insight into today's events in the Middle East, from 1958:

"The current crisis in the Arab East might well be qualified as the gravest since the war. The aggression of the United States and Britain in the Lebanon and Jordan has brought mankind to the brink of another world war. It stands apart from all the previous crises in that this time the United States has decided to inflict a crushing blow to the Arab national-liberation movement by force of arms..."

Historical prime sources on events leading up to the Bay of Pigs invasion in Cuba, from 1960:

"...the Central Intelligence Agency of the United States had organized a number of uprisings which were crushed by the Cuban Government in September and October. The plans of American intelligence called for the formation of several groups of saboteurs in the mountainous district in the central part of the country..."

The thawing of the Cold War, from 1988:

"The Moscow summit, during which the two sides exchanged instruments of ratification of the INF Treaty, saw the signing of a number of agreements and witnessed a substantive dialogue on a wide range of problems, is history now. ...The event lent a new quality to Soviet-American relations and the international atmosphere by bringing realism and readiness for cooperation to the fore."
